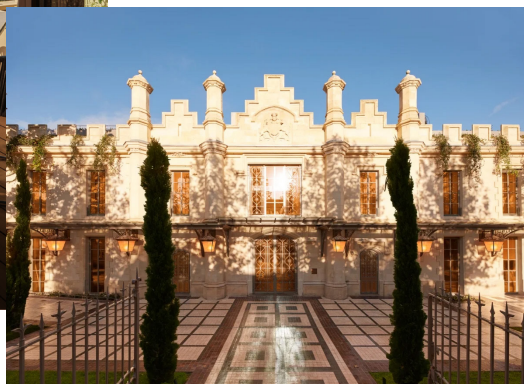

River Cruising

PORTO & THE DOURO VALLEY

Porto's tiled hillsides lead to the winding heart of the Douro Valley – a journey shaped by texture, tempo, and thoughtful access. Enjoy a private blending workshop in a working Port cellar, cruise the same waterways once navigated by wooden rabelos, and venture by 4x4 into the hills along the river. Dinners unfold in chef-owned kitchens, ancient rock art is seen by starlight, and in quiet settings reserved just for Roam by Tauck.

A DAY, YOUR WAY

Your time in Porto begins with a choice: explore the city's wine legacy through a guided tasting, or sample its culinary culture on a food-focused walking tour. In the afternoon, bike along the coast or catch a few waves with a local surf instructor. Each experience is designed to match your pace – actively, immersively, or not at all.



From the cabana-style loungers to the all-day bar service, life aboard your riverboat is designed for ease. Spend the afternoon by the plunge pool or sip something local in the lounge – with no need to pack or plan between stops. Dining is at leisure, drinks are included, and the sundeck is always just a few steps away.

River Cruising

PRAGUE & THE DANUBE

Castles by morning, riverside cafés by afternoon, and a waltz lesson in a Viennese palace. Rafting alongside the Danube, then sipping Grüner Veltliner in a Wachau tavern. This is a journey shaped by contrast – stately cities and slow rivers, bold flavors and quiet paths. With two nights in storybook Prague and seven along the water, each day shifts – not just where you are, but how you move through it.

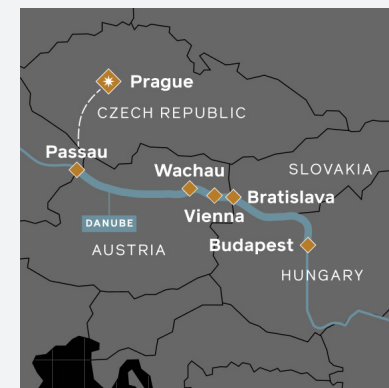

CHOICE, CURATED

In Bratislava, start the day rafting alongside the Danube or exploring a contemporary art museum tucked just beyond the city. Spend the afternoon wandering Old Town at your pace. From biking in Vienna to gliding past vineyards in the Wachau Valley, each day offers movement, stillness, and a rhythm that's yours to set.



In Prague, arrival comes with keys to a quieter side of the city. The Augustine, your hotel and a still-active monastery tucked behind stone walls, offers a personal welcome: a walk through cloistered corridors, a taste of beer still brewed under monastic tradition.

SAN SEBASTIÁN & RIOJA

Northern Spain is a retreat for the senses. Begin on turquoise shores, where life moves with the tide – and bold flavors pour from bite-sized pintxos in a city celebrated for its cuisine. Along the Basque coast, hike a stretch of the Camino de Santiago and visit a centuries-old salt valley. Then in Rioja, stay at Hotel Marqués de Riscal, voted the “world’s best vineyard” in 2024, cycle through vineyards, and savor a tasting dinner overseen by a Michelin-starred chef.

BORDEAUX & THE DORDOGNE

The countryside is where the French way of life feels most at ease. In Bordeaux, find it tasting wine with an expert, climbing Europe's highest sand dune, on an Arcachon Bay boat ride, and wine tasting at a private château in St. Émilion. In the Dordogne, it's biking to a picnic lunch, kayaking past ruins, standing in the mesmerizing Lascaux II – opened just for you – dining at a Michelin-starred table, and mornings rising slowly at Le Moulin du Roc, your five-star retreat.

For an entire day, enjoy a private car and driver all to yourself. In Bordeaux, discovery is yours to shape – from time to explore the city at your own pace to an immersive visit to Cité du Vin, where a guided oenology experience brings the region to life through six tastings. Opt in for a guided walk through Bordeaux's historic heart, then head beyond the city to climb the Dune du Pilat for sweeping Atlantic views.

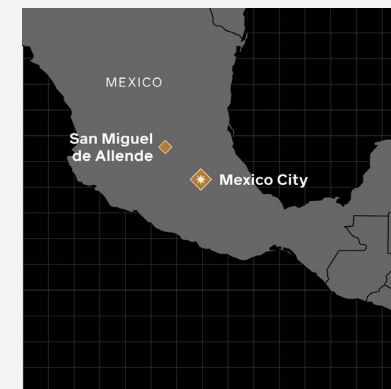
MEXICO CITY & SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

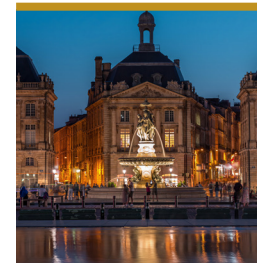

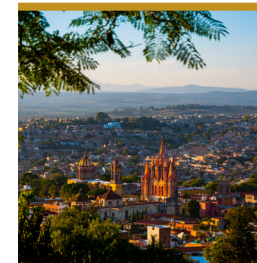
